Home Enrichment Activities:

- Make a car track using masking or painter's tape on the floor for your child. Make sure to add lots of twists and turns. Then, let your child "drive" on the track, reminding them to stay on the road.
- Have some fun with a "modes of transportation" shape craft! Cut out lots of different shapes out of paper, such as rectangles, triangles, and circles. Then, let your child glue them onto a larger paper to make different modes of transportation, such as cars, trains, buses, etc. See how many they can make!
- Make a paper airplane with your child! Get a blank piece of paper and let your child color it. Then, fold it to make an airplane. Help your child launch it and see how far it goes!
- Go "fishing for men" with your child. Write the names of the twelve disciples on pieces of paper (cut out to look like fish) and grab a straw. You'll use the straw to suck up the fish. You are ready to go straw fishing!
