**Enrichment Activities:**



- Thank God for creating our world!
- Talk about and show ways we can take care of the earth, such as recycling, turning off the lights in rooms you're not using, turning off the water faucet while brushing your teeth & while lathering your hands, and showing your family how grown-ups can cut plastic soda rings, so animals don't get stuck in them.
- Help your child recycle by separating recyclables from trash. If you have a small trash can, let your child use it to throw trash away. They will enjoy this project!
- See how many blue and green items you and your child can find around your home.
- Get your hands dirty - plant a tree or some flowers!
- Discuss the Bible story "The First Church" from Acts 2:42-47. The First Church was made up of Jesus' Disciples and people who put their trust in Jesus. They listened to the Disciples teach the Bible, spent time talking and listening to each other, remembered how Jesus died on the cross and came back to life, and prayed (talked to God) together. They met together every day and ate food in each other's homes. They felt happy as they thanked God and sang praise songs. They enjoyed sharing and helping each other, as they continued to learn about how much God loved them! The First Church was a wonderful example for us to follow, to show our love for God & each other!
