Home Enrichment Activities:

- Make binoculars with your child! Save two toilet paper tubes and have your child decorate them with any art supplies you have in the house. Then, glue the tubes together and let it dry. After your binoculars are dry, go to the park to go bird watching!
- Create a bird feeder with your child! Spread nut butter on a pine cone and roll it in bird seed. Hang it somewhere outside where it will be easy to spot birds as they eat their snack!
- Have fun practicing the ABCs in sign language with your child. There is a picture below for reference.
- Help your child practice printing the letter “V” and numbers 20 – 30. Then, help them circle each letter and number, using a red crayon or marker!
- Make some unleavened bread with your child. You can find a simple recipe at www.allrecipes.com/recipe/241680/unleavened-bread-for-communion/ or by googling “recipe for unleavened bread”. While you are mixing the ingredients, ask your child to tell you the Bible story of the Last Supper, as we have discussed in class this week. As the bread is baking, read the story together in the Bible (Mark 14:12-25). While you eat the bread together, pray and thank Jesus for coming to earth to die on the cross and rise again so that we can be with Him if we believe!
