Unit of Study:

Week's Work:

Students will discuss pets and how to care for them. We will learn the proper printing and hard sound for the letter "Cc". We will work on our number recognition, finger spelling our names and counting 1 - 20 in ASL. Also, we will be discussing where we live: the state, city, & street name.

Phonics:
(hard c sound).

Connie Cow C says, "c(k) - c, c, c" as in cat, calf, camel, car, & color



Rhyming:

We will be making a list of words that rhyme with the word "cow", such as "how" and "now".

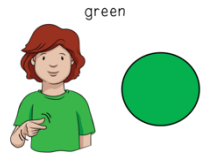
