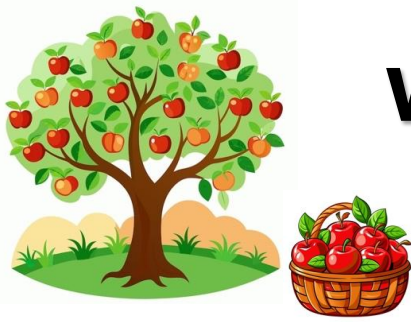

Unit of Study: Apples & Harvest

Bible Story: Joshua & the Battle of Jericho

Big Idea: God is powerful!

Home Enrichment Activities:

- **Talk about the Bible story** (from Joshua, chapters 5 & 6) with your family. Acting on instructions from the Lord, the Israelites marched around Jericho for seven days and conquered the city when its walls miraculously fell down. Remind your child that God is powerful! When we chose to obey God and follow Him, there is nothing He can't do for us!
- **Create an autumn sensory bin** with your child. You can fill it with items such as kernels of corn, dried leaves, and seeds. Use plastic spoons and cups to practice scooping and pouring for some fine motor development fun!
- **Make some homemade apple sauce.** You can go online for a simple recipe, such as the one found at <https://www.allrecipes.com/recipe/51301/sarahs-applesauce/>. Discuss with your child what the process is of making applesauce and how nutritious it can be!
- **Compare 3 different types of apples:** yellow, red, and green. Notice the similarities in size, shape, etc. Carefully cut open the 3 apples and notice how each have seeds inside. Contrast the differences: colors, tastes, etc. How do they smell? How does each taste - sweet or sour? After tasting each apple, ask your child to describe their tasting experience and which apple they prefer.
