Home Enrichment Activities:

- Have your child help you point out safety signs as you are driving. Ask them questions about the signs they see. For example, "What do you think that yellow triangle sign means?" or, "Why do you think we have to stop at this stop sign?"
- Practice holding a pencil, crayons, and/or markers using the correct "pincer" grip to write the letter, number, and shape of the week.
- Write upper case and lower-case letters A, B, and C on a piece of paper. Ask your child to choose a crayon or marker to circle all the upper-case letter A's. When they have finished, have them choose a new color for the lower-case a's. Continue with new colors for each letter until all of the letters are circled.
- Play "hide baby Moses" with your child. Ask your child to pretend to be the princess or Pharaoh and have them wait in the other room while you hide "baby Moses". When you're ready, ask your child to come find "baby Moses" just like the princess did!
