Home Enrichment Activities:



- Go on a shamrock hunt with your child! Print out some pictures of shamrocks or cut some out using green construction paper, then hide them around your house and let your child find them. After, you can let your child hide them and you find them!
- Make a fun St. Patrick's Day rainbow craft using a piece of paper, Froot Loops, and glue! Start by pouring out some of the cereal and sorting them by color. Then, start gluing them onto the paper in a rainbow shape. You can even have a few as a snack as you make your St. Patrick's Day rainbow!
- Play "Will It Float?" with your child! Fill a large bin or kiddie pool with water and gather some different items from around the house to test.
