Enrichment Activities:

- **Read a book about flowers** and blossoms. Have fun looking at all the different kinds of flowers and blossoms God has created! Your child can also learn the different names for each flower. Thank God for all the beautiful flowers!
- **Plant some flower seeds** and help your child water them each day. Have fun watching them grow! Your child will really enjoy this activity.
- **See how many square-shaped items** you can find around your house.
- **Look for pink items** inside and outside of your house. Have your child name the items.
- **Go outside and pick different flowers** and have your child help you put them in a vase or any container you are able to find. Your child will delight in helping you arrange the flowers. You can use artificial flowers too!
- **Discuss the Bible story "Pentecost"** from Acts 2: When the day of Pentecost came, the believers in Jesus were all together in one place. Suddenly there was a very loud sound, like a rushing wind, that came down from heaven. They saw what looked like "tongues of fire" that rested on top of each of them. They were all filled with the Holy Spirit and they began to speak in different languages! A crowd of people started gathering because the people heard them speaking, and they wondered how the believers were able to speak in the different languages. Then Peter, one of Jesus's disciples, stood up and spoke from the Bible and shared how Jesus died on the cross for our sins, rose on the 3rd day, and how Jesus is the Lord! The people asked, "what shall we do?" Peter told them to repent (say sorry to God) and be baptized (go under the water & come back up to declare their faith in Jesus). Those who listened and believed were baptized. About 3,000 people joined the believers that day!
