Home Enrichment Activities:

- Have a family beach day! Have your child help you plan and pack all the items you will bring: swim clothes, water shoes, beach towels, sheet/beach chairs, umbrella, hat/sunglasses, food & drinks, sand toys, etc. Remember your sunscreen!
- Take a walk together on the beach and collect seashells. Notice differences in size, color, and shape. Count the shells to see how many you collected and have fun sorting them or using them to make sand creations, etc.
- Play a game of "Marco Polo" with your child inside! Remember to clear the room of any potential tripping hazards! After the game, talk to your child about how it is difficult to navigate when we can't see anything! Remind them how Jesus healed a man who was born blind. Ask them how they think that man might have felt after Jesus healed him!
