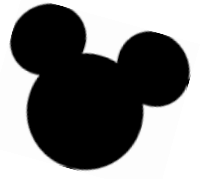

Home Enrichment Activities:

- Pretend to be zoo animals with your child! Ask your child what kinds of animals they might find in the zoo. When they mention one, ask your child what sound the animal makes or what the animal might do (ex. bray like a zebra, stretch your neck like a giraffe, waddle like a penguin). Have fun being some of the wild and crazy animals that God has made!
- Invite your child to make a zoo at home using their stuffed animals. Have your child help you sort the animals and put each kind into a box or some kind of container to represent their zoo enclosure. Now you and your child can be the zookeepers! Ask your child what they think a zookeeper does. Make sure you wash and feed your zoo animals!
- Set aside some special time with your child to pray for your family. Remind them that God always answers our prayers! Sometimes He says yes, sometimes no, and sometimes He tells us to wait!
