**Unit of Study:**

Me! My Body!

**Week's Work:**

Students will learn & discuss how God made them, how they are unique and how each child is gifted in their own special way. We will learn the proper printing and sound for the long "Aa" sound. We will work on spelling our names out loud and with ASL fingerspelling. This helps our auditory development, name recognition, as well as our fine motor skills. We will be working on strengthening our fine motor skills, as well as working on the recognition of our numbers 1 - 10.

**Phonics:**

Long A says, "a – as in ape, acorn, aim & ate". Long A says, "a – a, a, a".

**Weekly Academic Practice:**

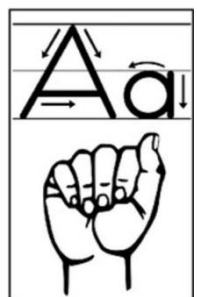
**Shape:** Circle



**Number:** One



**Color:** Red. We will be looking at items that are red in color. We will look in nature, in books, foods we eat, as well as the clothes we wear. I encourage the children to continue this activity at home, discovering items in their life that are the color red.



**Rhyming:**

We will be making a list of words that rhyme with the long "Aa" sound, such as "tape" and "cape".

**Bible Story:**

The Garden of Eden – Adam and Eve in the Garden

**Bible Verse:**

"In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth." -Genesis 1:1

**Share Day:**

Each week your child can bring one item related to our unit of study. During the share time your child will speak in front of their peers, describing the item and its importance to them. This develops their verbal skills and confidence in expressing themselves to others. Share days will be as follows:  
3 Day and 5 Day students will share on Friday.  
2 Day students will share on Thursday.

**Featured Composer:**

Every month we will learn about and listen to a famous classical music composer during our art and quiet activity time. We will learn fun facts about their lives and try to identify their songs. This month our featured composer is Ludwig Van Beethoven.

**Enrichment Activities:**

- \*Find different items in your house that start with the long "Aa Ape" sound.
- \*On a shopping trip, see how many fruits or veggies you can find that are red.
- \*While in the car, look at license plates, and count how many have the number 1 in them.
- \*Practice saying your weekly Bible verse, Genesis 1:1. Ask a family member to help you or even memorize it with you!
