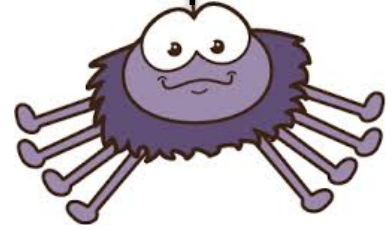


# Mrs. Porteneuve's

- Search "nursery rhymes for kids" on YouTube and sing along to some of your favorites! Nursery Rhymes help children learn in so many ways, like storytelling, sequencing, and can boost language development.
- Our names are so important to us! There are so many cognitive benefits in learning our names. Recognizing one's name helps children feel important, recognizing others' names builds community, name recognition builds concepts of print and begins the process of sight reading. We will be working on name activities in the upcoming weeks. You can help your child start writing their name by writing it with a highlighter and having them trace over it. Make sure you say each letter as they write it for extra letter recognition practice!
- Read about "Samuel Hears God Speak" in 1 Samuel chapter 3. God speaks to us in many ways. The Bible, prayer, and music just to name a few. The more we are in His word easier it is for us to hear His voice. Thank you, God, for speaking to us and teaching us the way in which to walk!
