Bible Story: God's Faithful Promise to Abraham

Big Idea: God Keeps His Promises!

Bible Verse: "For I know the plans I have for you, plans to prosper you and not harm you, plans to give you a future and a hope." Jeremiah 29:11

Enrichment Activities:

- **Talk to your child about how God is our Heavenly Father** who loves us so much! He takes care of us and is always with us. We can pray to God anytime of the day or night. He will always listen to us and He will always answer our prayers in His own perfect timing.
- **Make a special treat** for your father, grandpa, uncle or a special father you know.
- **Dads: Have your child help you** complete the tasks that you have to do on a regular basis. After, have a conversation about what they thought about it and if they would someday like to be a parent.
- **Look at photo albums** and talk about how you and your child are related to the people in the photos. Take time to talk about the people that make up your family with your child.
- **On a clear night, take your family to look up at the stars** and try to count them. Then remind them of God's promise to Abraham that he would have as many descendants as the stars in the sky. Genesis 15:5-6 says, *He took him outside and said, "Look up at the sky and count the stars—if indeed you can count them." Then He said to him, "So shall your offspring be." Abram believed the Lord, and He credited it to him as righteousness.* Remind them that God always keeps His promises!
