Home Enrichment Activities:



- Spread some shaving cream on a cookie sheet and let your child print letters and numbers in the shaving cream using their finger or a paintbrush. To extend this activity, add food coloring to the shaving cream!
- Make Valentine's Day cookies with your child! Cut sugar cookie dough into hearts, bake them, and have fun decorating them with all kinds of Valentine's Day themed decorations! (The grocery store also has pre-made heart cookies if you want to skip a step!) Ask your child to help you think of some people they love, then gift those people some of the beautiful cookies you made together!
- Did you know George Washington wrote a book about proper etiquette? Have a tea party with your child to help them practice their manners.
- Continue to help your child practice their home address and phone number. I will be sending home special prizes for students who can recite each of these in class!
- Read the Bible story (Luke 19:1-10) together with your family. Then, act out the story (by going to a park or if you have a tree in your backyard) and help your child to climb a tree, then sit on the tree limb, looking for Jesus. Mom or dad, pretend to be Jesus looking up at Zacchaeus. Say, "Zacchaeus, come down out of that tree, for I want to have lunch at your house." Then, after helping your child climb down, have a yummy lunch together and talk about what Jesus and Zacchaeus discussed during their lunch at Zacchaeus' house. Jesus had told Zacchaeus, "Today, salvation has come to this house..."
