Home Enrichment Activities:

- Go on a "leaf hunt" with your child around your neighborhood. Take a bag with you to hold the leaves as you collect them. When you get home, have your child sort the leaves by size, color, or shape!
- Take a trip to the park to explore the nature in autumn. Pack a picnic lunch full of foods that are in season. (Some of my favorites are apples, corn, and squash!) Heritage Park is a great place to go; it has a lake, a playground, and plenty of trees!
- Have fun practicing our academics this week: use a brown crayon or marker to practice writing, or draw in sand, or form with playdough (letter "E, e", number "8", "oval" shape).
- Find a simple recipe for matzah bread online and have your child help you make it. While it's baking, talk about how the Israelites had to be ready to leave Egypt when God told them to, and they couldn't wait for their bread to rise (get big and puffy!) so they had unleavened bread (flat bread!) to take with them on their journey to the land God promised them.
