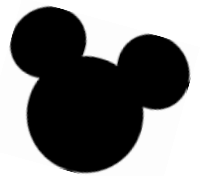

Bible Story: The Good Samaritan

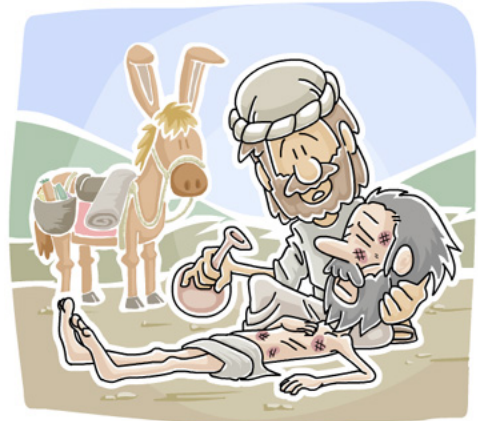
Big Idea: Jesus says, "Love your neighbor!"
