**Sight Words:** The sight words for this week are: "like", "my" and "find".

## **Home Enrichment Activities:**

- Take a walk to a park or in your neighborhood and look for different kinds of flowers. See how many you can name.
- Go to your local gardening center with your child and take a walk through their flower section. After you have finished, have your child help you choose some seeds to plant in your backyard (or in a pot). Ask them to tell you what flowers need in order to grow. Remember to plant something that is in season!
- Talk about how God helps us to grow like a flower. We may start out small, but He helps us blossom into His beautiful creation.
- Ask your child to tell you the different parts of the flower.
- Read the "Parable of the Sower" in Matthew 13 of the Bible. Have a discussion of what this means, especially to have "good soil". Pray and thank God for His Word, which is like a seed that grows in us!
- Have fun singing and acting out this song with your child:  
*"Read your Bible, pray every day, pray every day, pray every day. Read your Bible, pray every day and you'll grow, grow, grow. And you'll grow, grow, grow. Read your Bible, pray every day and you'll grow, grow, grow!"*
