Home Enrichment Activities:



- Make a fun rain craft with your child! You'll need white paper, water, blue food coloring, an eye dropper, a straw, glue, and cotton balls. Mix some blue food coloring into the water. Using the eye dropper, put some blue water drops at the top of the paper. Let your child use the straw to blow the "rain drops" down the paper. When the paper is dry, add some cotton balls with glue for the clouds!
- Make some "snow" with your child! In a large bowl, mix 3 cups of baking soda with ½ cup of white hair conditioner until firm. Then, have some fun with your "snow"!
- Make a "find it" bottle with your child! Get a bottle, rice, and some small items that can fit inside, such as pom-pom balls, beads, small erasers, etc. Fill the bottle with rice and put the small items into the bottle, then close it. Shake it up so that the small items are all through the bottle. Take some time to see if you and your child can find all of the items. After, remind your child that when Jesus was a boy, His parents thought He was lost and had to go find Him.
