Home Enrichment Activities:

- Make binoculars with your child! Save two toilet paper tubes, or cut a paper towel tube in half, and have your child decorate them with any art supplies you have in the house. Then, glue the tubes together and let it dry. After your binoculars are dry, go to the park to go bird watching!
- Create a bird feeder with your child! Spread peanut butter on a pine cone and roll it in bird seed. Hang it somewhere outside where it will be easy to spot birds as they eat their snack!
- Take your child to a park that has a pond to watch and count the ducks. Ask your child to become a duck with you. Waddle and quack your way around the park!
- Recreate the Last Supper with your child! Spread a table cloth over the table or on the floor. Grab several stuffed animals to be Jesus' disciples and line them up around the cloth. Give yourself, your child, and the "disciples" some bread and grape juice and read the story about the last supper from the Bible (Mark 14:22-25). Ask your child questions to create discussion. How did Jesus celebrate the Passover feast with his friends? Can you remember anything Jesus said to his friends?
