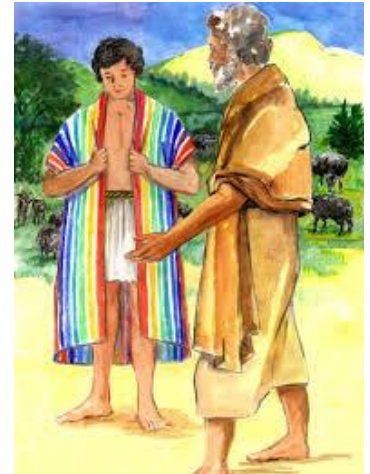
**Unit of Study:** Pets

## **Home Enrichment Activities:**

- Engage your child in pretend play where you are both pets. Ask your child questions about what you would look like if you were a certain pet. (Example: "Woof! I'm a dog! What do my ears look like?") Then, see if they can guess what kind of pet you are by the description you give them. (Example: "I have whiskers and love to eat cheese. When I talk, I say, 'Squeak!' What kind of pet do you think I am?")
- If you have a pet at home, include your child in taking care of it this week. Your child can help you feed the cat, wash the dog, or clean out the fish bowl! If you don't have a pet at home, use a stuffed toy for a substitute. Even stuffed dogs need to be walked!
- Make a coat of many colors, just like the one Joseph wore! Use a paper towel tube and different colored yarn or tissue paper. Glue the yarn, or tissue paper, onto the paper tube and decorate. Add some eyes, nose, and mouth to make him look like Joseph from the Bible.
