Unit of Study:

Zoo animals

Week's Work:

Students will discuss zoo animals. We will learn the proper printing and sound for the short letter "Ee". We will work on our number recognition, finger spelling our names and counting 1 - 20 is ASL. Also, we will be discussing where we live: the state, city, & street name.

We will be making a list of words that rhyme with the word "egg", such as "beg" and "leg".

Weekly Academic Practice:

I encourage the children to continue this activity at home, discovering items in their life that are the color white. During the week, if a student wears an article of clothing that is white, they will receive a special sticker.

Enrichment Activities:

- *Find different items in your house that start with the short "Ee" sound.
- *Practice signing greeting signs and our opposite signs.
- *Practice signing ASL "animal" signs and our "opposite" signs.
