Home Enrichment Activities:



- Ask your child who is special to them, such as a family member or a friend. Help them to make a Valentine for that person using craft supplies, such as construction paper, markers, crayons, glitter, and glue. When it's ready, help them deliver the Valentine to that person!
- Build a model of the Lincoln Memorial using pasta, playdough, and a picture of Lincoln or a small toy figure. Use the playdough to stick the pasta together to build the chair for Lincoln (rigatoni or ziti are good pasta options). Then, place your Lincoln (picture or small toy figure) onto the chair. Now you have a mini pasta Lincoln Memorial.
- Ask your child what they can do. Then, ask them if they can do anything. After, remind them that Jesus can do anything! Take some time praising Jesus, because He can do anything!
