While they were attending this celebration, the wine ran out. Jesus' mother Mary tells the servants to do what Jesus tells them to do. A servant is a person who works for another person. Now there were six water pots. A water pot is a jar that holds water. So, the servants fill the pots up to the very top. Jesus told them to take some of the pots to the headwaiter to taste. A headwaiter is the person in charge of the people handling the food. He took a taste and discovered that the pots were filled with wine, not water. Jesus had turned the water into wine! How exciting it must have been to see Jesus perform this miracle. A miracle is something special that only God can do!
