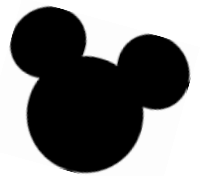

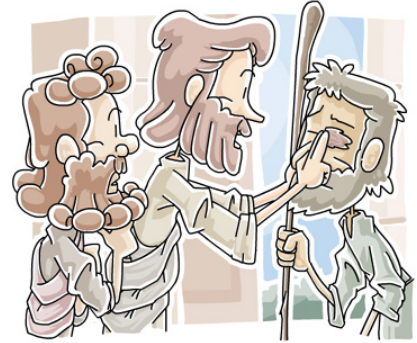
**Unit of Study:** Beach – Sand, Ocean, Shells
