Home Enrichment Activities:

- Each day your child attends school this week, encourage them to find out the name of another student in our class. Remind them on the way to school, then ask them who they met when you're on your way home!
- Help your child fill out the "About Me" worksheet that was sent home in their cubby. Save it in a special place to pull out and read at the end of the school year!
- Each of us were in created in the image of God. Psalm 139:13-16 tells us that God created us and knows us inside and out.
