

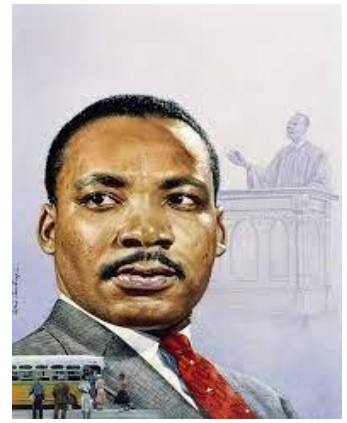

**Home Enrichment Activities:**

- Check out a book at the library about Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. After reading the story with your child, talk about how Martin Luther King loved Jesus, gave speeches, and marched in protests, to help American people. Thank God for the differences he and so many other brave men and women had standing up for equal rights for his brothers and sisters, and all people.
- Discuss snowflakes with your child. Each one has six points and is unique. Just as God makes no two snowflakes the same, so are we, created by God, especially unique!
- Help your child understand that even though the wind is invisible, we can still see the effects of the wind. Compare that to *God* and how, even though we can't see Him, we can see evidence of Him all around us in our lives and in His creation.
