Home Enrichment Activities:

- As you prepare for your Thanksgiving meal, find ways to include your child. Ask them to be your helper as you go to the store to buy food or help you prepare a dessert for Thanksgiving. They will enjoy being your helper!
- Act out the Bible story, "Daniel and the Lions' Den," from Daniel 6. King Darius made a law, saying that no one was allowed to pray to God. Daniel loved God and he continued to pray to God. He went to his room, and with his window open, he prayed morning, noon, and night. Some people saw Daniel pray and told the king. The king had his guards take Daniel to the lions' den.
