Home Enrichment Activities:

- Go to your local gardening center with your child and take a walk through their flower section. After you have finished, have your child help you choose some seeds to plant in your backyard (or in a pot). Ask them to tell you what flowers need to grow. Remember to plant something that is in season!
- Take your child to the park and see if you can find some flowers growing. Ask your child to tell you the different parts of the flower.
- Find some flowers with long stems. Engage your child in an art activity, using the flowers as paintbrushes.
- Using chalk, write capital and lowercase letters A – X on the sidewalk. Then fill a watering can or cup with water and ask your child to identify, then “water” each letter.
- Bake together with your child. Make a cake to celebrate the birth of the church. Red icing and candles serve as great reminders of the Spirit coming as individual flames and resting on each of the disciples.
