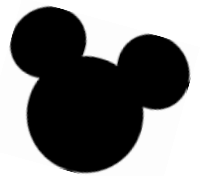

Home Enrichment Activities:

- Go to a local duck pond and observe the ducks! Ask your child to count and describe the ducks. What colors are on the ducks? How many ducks are there?
- Make a "Last Supper" craft with your child. You'll need a plain white paper plate, a plain paper cup, and something to decorate with, such as markers, crayons, or stickers. Have a conversation with your child as they are decorating. Remind them that the bread that Jesus broke might have been on a plate and the wine was in a cup. When we look at the plate and cup, we can remember Jesus and His sacrifice for us, as well as that Jesus says, "Remember me"!
