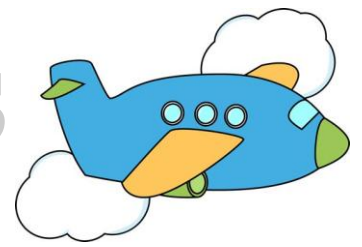

- Read about “The Good Samaritan” in Luke 10:25-37. Jesus told a parable about a man who was traveling when some robbers came and stole from him and hurt him. A priest walked by and did not help him; a Levite walked by and did not help him. Finally, a Samaritan (who would have been like an enemy to the hurt man) stopped and helped him. The Samaritan man took the hurt man to an inn and paid for him to be taken care of. Jesus used this story to talk to the people about loving your neighbor as yourself.
