Home Enrichment Activities:

- Start a discussion with your child about what it means to be a family. Talk about aunts and uncles, explaining that relationship you have with them. Share with your child how Grandpa and Grandma are related to Mommy and Daddy! Then dig deeper, telling them how a family sticks together and has fun together!
- Ask your child about any friends he or she has made at school, church, the park, etc. Children start to become more social with their peers right around three or four years of age. Make an effort to encourage their friendships. Find another family who has a child the same age as your child and set up a play date for them!
- Grab some sheets and pillows, with your child, and build a “pretend” ark! Bring some stuffed toy animals or animal items they might have and put them inside your ark. Ask your child how Noah might have felt with all those animals in the ark with him.
