Share Time: Children may bring one item related to health and safety.

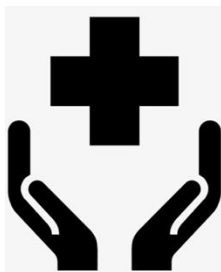

Home Enrichment Activities:

- Take your child on a walk around your neighborhood. Use this opportunity to teach your child about how to be safe while they are outside! While you are walking, point out the safety signs that you see. Explain to your child what each one means. Remind your child how to look both ways before crossing the street. Also remind them to only cross the street with a grown-up!
- Have your child help you wash the dishes, one night, after dinner. (Try using plastic dishes on this night, to avoid anything breaking. 😊) While you are washing and drying dishes, engage your child in a conversation about how cleaning things properly is a part of staying healthy!
- Begin a conversation with your child about the Ten Commandments by discussing the first five of them. Choose one to focus on with your child each day of the school week. Remind your child (and yourself!) that God gave us these commandments to remind us that we need Him!

1. You shall have no other gods before me.
2. You shall not make for yourself an idol.
3. You shall not misuse the name of the LORD your God.
4. Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy.
5. Honor your father and mother.
