Unit of Study: Pilgrims

<u>Bible Story</u>: The Burning Furnace

## Home Enrichment Activities:

- Using a large box or basket, make a "boat" with your child. After reminding your child that the pilgrims came to America in a boat called the Mayflower, have them help you name your boat. Discuss how the Pilgrims wanted to come to the new land where they could be free to worship God.
- Act out some ways that the Pilgrims would have lived: traveling by boat, building a log cabin, cleaning, making the clothes, fetching water, cooking, farming, giving thanks, etc.
- Play a Pilgrim game with your child: "Al Hid" (Hide & Go Seek), "Naughts and Crosses" (Tic Tac Toe), "Hop Frog" (Leap Frog), or "Lummelen" (Keep Away). Have fun playing the games!
- Read the story of "The Burning Furnace" found in Daniel 3. The three men trusted that God
  could save them, and He did. Remind your child that God is always with them and still performs
  amazing miracles today!

<u>Reminder</u>: Please put your child's name on all their belongings before bringing them to school (water bottles, jackets, lunches, etc.) This helps avoid confusion. Thank you!
