**Unit of Study:** Fall Season: Fall Leaves, Cooler Weather

**Bible Story:** The Passover & Freedom for the Israelites

**Bible Verse:** (Joshua 24:24) We will serve the Lord our God and obey Him.

**Phonics:** This week's letter: Bell B b - The jingle is: B says "b", as in bell. B says, "b, b, b".

This week's blends are: ba, be, bi, bo, bu (using the short vowel sound).

**Academics to Practice this Week:** Number: 8 Shape: Triangle Color: black (Students may earn a sticker for wearing the color of the week.)

**Manuscript Printing:** Continue to practice printing Aa, Ee, Ii, Oo and Uu using the Manuscript Printing Guide you received. Also, please continue to encourage your child when printing, to use "pointer and thumb" and make sure their pencil is resting comfortably next to their thumb, allowing other fingers to naturally fall under the pencil.

**Sharetime:** The students may bring one item related to Fall.

### **Home Enrichment Activities:**

- I would like to encourage you to take your child on a short nature walk around your neighborhood to collect some fall leaves. Take the leaves home and have your child sort them by color and then by shape.
- Talk to your child about the transition from summer to fall. Discuss the seasons and how the leaves change colors before they fall, the weather becomes cooler, and the days grow shorter.
- The students recently learned about God creating the earth and everything in it. Read Genesis 8:22 to your child and discuss how God made the changing seasons throughout the year.
