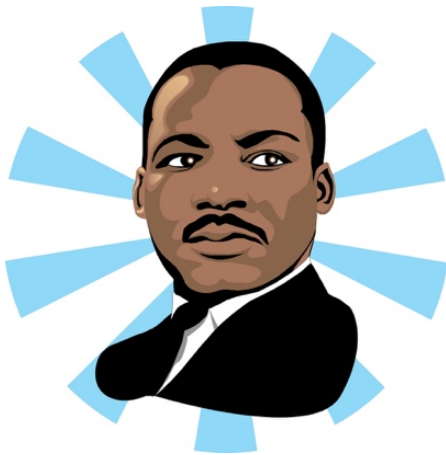
Bible Story: Jesus' Baptism
