## **Home Enrichment Activities:**

- Make "bird watcher" binoculars with your child: cut an empty paper towel roll in half and tape them together to look like binoculars. Your child can decorate them any way they like. Attach string if you wish, to wear them around your neck. Then, go to the park to go bird watching!
- Create a bird feeder with your child! Spread nut butter on a pinecone and roll it in bird seed. Hang it somewhere outside where it will be easy to spot birds as they eat their snack!
- Spread some shaving cream on a cookie sheet and let your child print letters and numbers in the shaving cream using their finger or a paintbrush. To extend this activity, add food coloring to the shaving cream!
- Jesus said in Matthew 6:26, "Look at the birds of the air; they do not sow or reap, or store in barns, and yet your Heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not much more valuable than they?" Have a five-minute Bible devotion on the verses Matthew 6:25-33 with your family. What is Jesus saying about worrying about things? What does God want us to do instead?
