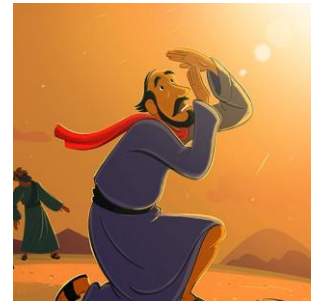

Bible Story: Paul's Conversion

Big Idea: Jesus can change my heart!

Share Time: Share Day: Please have your child bring 1 "green" item relating to Earth Day, or that starts with letter "W" this Thursday or Friday! **Please label your child's share item with their name.**

Home Enrichment Activities:

- **Read the story of Paul's conversion in a Children's Bible.** It is found in Acts 9. Remind your child that with Jesus' help, anyone can change!
- **Find items that you have used in your home that you can find another use for,** make something new with or find a way to "recycle" that item. Brainstorm with your child: what can you make with these things that would be otherwise considered "trash"? Remind them that recycling is one way we can keep our earth clean.
- **Take your child to the park to help clean up the earth!** Take a trash bag, wear gloves, and remember to wash your hands when you're done! Remind your child that God gave us the earth, so we need to take care of it!
- **Help your child make a yummy Earth Day snack!** Using blueberries, cut green grapes, cream cheese, and a rice cake, create the earth!
- **Read "The Lorax" by Dr. Seuss with your child. Then, discuss more ways we can take care of the earth.** Examples may include: saving energy by turning off the lights in rooms you're not using, conserving water by turning off the faucet while brushing your teeth & while lathering you're your hands and showing your family how to cut plastic soda rings, so animals don't get stuck in them.
