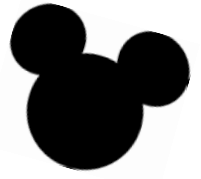

Home Enrichment Activities:

- Make a Christmas Advent Chain with your child! Follow this link to a printable advent chain: <https://activitiesforkids.com/advent-calendar-paper-chain/>. You can use red and green paper or use white paper and allow your child to color each slip. Have fun taking each chain off and reading it as you get closer and closer to Christmas!
- Make an angel with your child! Here's a link to an example: <https://ourpotluckfamily.com/christmas-craft-paper-plate-angel/>. You'll need a paper plate, construction paper, scissors, tape or glue, and markers or crayons. Take the paper plate and allow your child to decorate it using the markers or crayons. Next, trace your child's hands on a piece of construction paper and cut out for the wings. Also cut a circle for your child to decorate for the angel's head. Cut a line from the edge to the center of the plate and roll to create a cone and tape it. Then, glue or tape on the head and wings. Now you have an angel to decorate your home with!
- Remind your child that God used Mary to bring Jesus into the world. Take some time to pray with your child. Thank God for the times when He uses them to do His work and ask Him to guide them to do His work.
