Home Enrichment Activities:



- Read your child some nursery rhymes before bed time. Tell your child what your favorite nursery rhyme was when you were a child and ask them which rhyme they like the best!
- Read "Hickory Dickory Dock" with your child. Then, pretend to be mice running up and down a clock. When you are done, have a mouse snack of cheese and crackers!
- Help your child practice memorizing your home address as you drive to and from school this week. Start by asking your child what our state is called. Next, ask about your city and street name. Finally, talk about your house or apartment number.
- Have fun practicing writing our academics this week using a white crayon on a black piece of paper! Help your child write our capital and lower case "F, f", as well as our number, 9. Then, draw a rectangle around each one!
- Our Bible story this week is about God speaking to Samuel. Talk to your child about how God still speaks to His children. One of the main ways He does this is through His Word, the Bible. Practice our Bible verse together and discuss how God tells us in this verse that He is always with those who believe in Him!
