

Home Enrichment Activities:

- Find a picture book, about "Samoset" and "Squanto" or Native American cultures, to read together Thanksgiving.
- Go online to www.food.com and type "Navajo Fry Bread" into the search bar. Click on the second recipe (the one with the picture) and make some Native American Indian Fry Bread with your child. Talk with your child about how different families eat different kinds of food!
- Using chalk, write capital and lowercase letters A I on the sidewalk. Then fill a watering can or cup with water and ask your child to identify, then "water" each letter.
- Read the story about Elijah helping a widow in a Children's Bible. It is found 1 Kings 17: Elijah visited a poor widow and her son. All she had was a little flour and a small amount of oil. But God spoke through Elijah and told her He would provide. "She went away and did as Elijah had told her. So there was food every day for Elijah and for the woman and her family. For the jar of flour was not used up and the jug of oil did not run dry, in keeping with the word of the Lord spoken by Elijah" (1 Kings 17:15-16). God shows that He can provide miraculously!
