Home Enrichment Activities:

- Take some time to exercise with your child this week. That could be a walk, bike ride, dance party. Help your child be active. Remind them that it is important to exercise to keep our bodies healthy.
- Have a tasty traffic light snack with your child. You'll need graham crackers, cream cheese, a green fruit (such as kiwi or green grapes), a red fruit (such as strawberries or raspberries), and a yellow fruit (such as banana or pineapple). Use these ingredients to create a traffic light. As you make the snack, talk to your child about what each color light means and that traffic lights help us drive safely.
- Play a "find baby Moses" game with your child! Hide a baby doll or small stuffed animal around the house. Remind your child that Moses' mom had to hide him for 3 months to keep him safe from Pharaoh. After a few rounds of hiding and finding Moses, remind your child that God had a plan for Moses, and so He helped keep him safe. Nothing is impossible with God!
