### **Home Enrichment Activities:**

- Practice fine motor skills with your child! You'll need Play-Doh, dry spaghetti, and Cheerios, or another small ring-shaped cereal. Stand the spaghetti straight up in the Play-Doh and allow your child to put the cereal onto the spaghetti until they fill the entire piece. If you use Froot Loops, you can add some color sorting or pattern making to the fun!
- This week, our color is red and our shape is a circle. Have your child go on a color and shape hunt around your house or neighborhood. See how many circle or red things your child can find!
- Have some Play-Doh fun with your child! Give your child some Play-Doh and ask them to create something found in nature – an animal, a flower, a fish, whatever they want. As they are making their creation, talk to them about how God made the whole world, including us, and how much He loves His creations.

**Welcome Letter:** Every student has a welcome letter in their cubby that explains important information about what our students participate in throughout the year. The "Welcome Letter" also informs you which day is your child's share day.
