Unit of Study: Christmas Advent Calendar, Christmas Chains, Angels

<u>Bible Story</u>: The Annunciation - Angel Gabriel Visits Mary

Big Idea: God can use me!

Bible Verse: "Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, rejoice!"

Philippians 4:4

<u>Share Time</u>: Children may bring <u>one</u> item related to Christmas (no Santa please) or something that is red to share with the class this Thursday <u>or</u> Friday! Please remember to label your child's share item with their name.



Home Enrichment Activities:

- Talk about ways we can show God's love to others at Christmas time!
- Make a Christmas paper chain. They're easy & fun to make! Make Christmas chains with your child by cutting up strips of red and green construction paper and taping or stapling each strip together to make a chain. Hang the chain up as decoration for Christmas.
- Get a Christmas Advent calendar or use a paper chain with 25 rings and write a number on each ring (1-25). Beginning on December 1^{st} , pull off one paper ring each day to count down to Christmas day!
- Read Luke 1:26-38. In our Bible story, Mary was visited by the angel Gabriel and told that she was
 chosen to give birth to the Messiah, Jesus, by the power of the Holy Spirit! Ask your child how they
 think Mary felt during this time. Mary accepted God's will and allowed God to use her for His glory!
 We too can be used for God's glory!
- Talk with your child about how angels are God's helpers and messengers.
