Home Enrichment Activities:

- **Have a special Bible devotion time:** What's the most valuable gift? Is it your money, your expensive gifts to the church? No, God wants all of us, and with our time, prayers, praise, and devotion to Him that is enough. - **Go to the library** and get a selection of Dr. Seuss books. If you can find "Green Eggs and Ham", read it. Then have your child help you cook scrambled eggs, with green food coloring & add some ham.
- **Read "Hop on Pop"** with your child. If you don't have this book, visit your local library to borrow it. After reading, take your child outside and draw a simple hopscotch for them using chalk. Then hop, hop, hop!
- **The "Cat in the Hat" tells Sally and her brother that he knows "a lot of good tricks."** He can balance the fish on his umbrella and balance on a ball! What can you do? Can you make your mouth make popping sounds? Can you curl your tongue? Can you whistle? Can you wiggle your eyebrows? Can you recite the alphabet backwards? Can you jump on one foot? Can you do 10 jumping jacks? **Have your child try balancing** unbreakable household items, like the Cat in the Hat did.
