Bible Story: Calling His Disciples

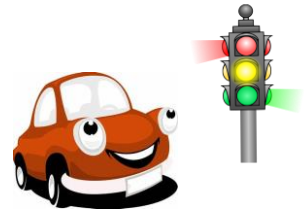
Share Time: Students may bring something relating to transportation to share with the class.
