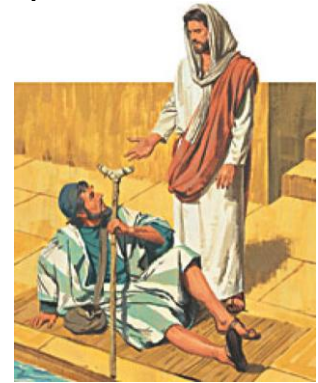
Unit of Study: Independence Day - 4th of July
