**Home Enrichment Activities:**

- **Read the story of "The Last Supper"** in a Children's Bible. It can be found in Luke 22:7-38 and John 13:1-17. At the meal, Jesus surprised His disciples by getting up and washing their feet. Normally this was a "servant's job". Jesus gave them an example and said for them to show love by serving others. Talk about ways we, too, can serve in love. ☺
- **Go out into your backyard or visit your neighborhood park and discover all the insects** of springtime! Remember to take a magnifying glass so that you can look very closely at the little guys! Then discuss events that happen in the springtime, insects are busy, baby animals are born, flowers are beginning to bloom, Jesus' resurrection (Easter) and the new life we can receive.
- **Observe animal babies by visiting a zoo, wildlife reserve, park, or petting zoo** to see baby animals in action this spring. You could visit the farm animals at **Centennial Farm**: 88 Fair Drive, Costa Mesa, CA. The phone number is (714) 708-1619. Admission is free. Hours open to the public are Monday - Friday, 1 - 4 pm and weekends, 10 am - 4 pm.
- **Have fun acting out the different baby animals** together: gallop like a colt (pony), jump like a joey (kangaroo), walk & flap wings while cheeping like a chick, crawl like a kitten, stomp like an elephant calf.
