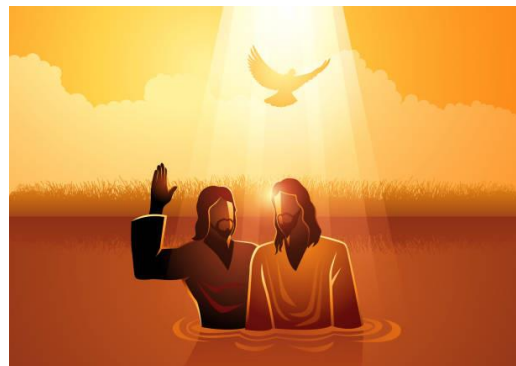
Unit of Study: Martin Luther King's Birthday
