Home Enrichment Activities:

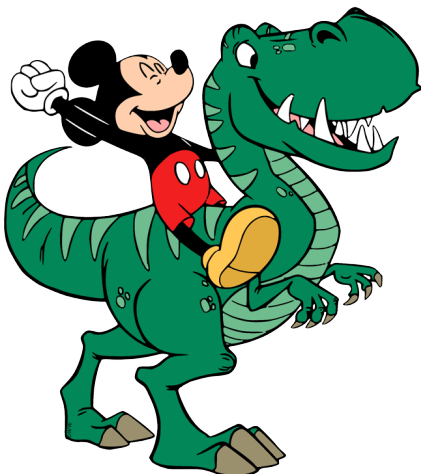
