**Home Enrichment Activities:**

- Go to your local library and pick out a book of nursery rhymes or fairy tales. Take it and home and read with your child. After reading, ask your child which was their favorite and why.
- Use blocks to create a bridge with your child. Once it is built, knock it down and sing "London Bridge is Falling Down".
- Create a "boat" with your child to sit in. Use objects from around the house, such as pillows, a box, or a large basket. Get inside your "boat" and sing "Row, Row, Row Your Boat".
- Have some quiet time with your child, just sitting and listening. After, ask your child to tell you about how God spoke to Samuel and how Samuel had to listen (this can be found in 1 Samuel 3). Remind them that God speaks to us too, and we should listen!
